Supplementary Anti-Social Behaviour Report Aberdeen City Centre

RESTRICTED

Between 1st September and 7th November 2016, there have been 40 Serious Assaults across Aberdeen City.

Sixteen of these Assaults occurred within the City Centre boundaries. Half of these occurred during the same Weekend Night Time Economy Hours as designated in the main report, and half did not.

Of the eight offences during these hours, three occurred within a City Centre Licensed Premises. Of the five offences not within licensed premises, one occurred immediately outside such a venue and the remaining four featured involved parties who were under the influence of alcohol at the time of the respective offence.

Of the remaining eight offences during the rest of the week, two occurred within a City Centre Licensed Premises.

Since September, just less than a third of Serious Assaults within Aberdeen City Centre occurred within a Licensed Premises.

Of the remaining 24 offences that occurred elsewhere in the Aberdeen, half took place during the Weekend Night Time hours as outlined in the main report.
