**Suggested certificate** – 12A (consequence implied, no bad language)

Title - Low battery

Running time – o1 minute o8 seconds

**Synopsis** – In a group of friends a girl notices her battery running low, later she tries to walk home drunk and cannot phone a taxi, she falls asleep on the ground outside.

**Suggested certificate** – 12A (consequence implied, no bad language)

Title - Online privacy

Running time - 01 minute 05 seconds

Synopsis - A couple of girls from a group of friends are taking photos while drunk, the photos are

posted online, as a result one of the girls employers sees this and she is dismissed from her job. **Suggested certificate** – 12A (consequence implied, no bad language)

Title - Walk away

Running time – o1 minute o2 seconds

Synopsis – A drunk guy is bumped into by someone walking along the street, they get into a fight and the drunk guy gets arrested and placed in a cell.

**Suggested certificate** – 15 (Physical assault implied, no bad language)

Title - What's in your drink

Running time o1 minute o2 seconds

**Synopsis** - A girl in a group of friends is talking to someone with her back to her drink when a stranger puts something in her drink. It then cuts to her in an ambulance seriously ill. **Suggested certificate** – 15 (drink being spiked and consequences implied, no bad language)
