This item was deferred from the Licensing Committee meeting on 26 April 2016.

The application requires to be determined by 15 May 2016 and we have not yet received a clear report from Building Standards in respect of the application.

The applicant is now also seeking to vary the licence upon renewal. When the licence was granted there was an agreement that capacity at level 2 of the aquatics centre would be restricted to 598 persons and that competitions would not be held in the diving and 50 metres pools simultaneously or consecutively. The applicant is now seeking to remove this restriction and increase capacity at level 2 to 729 persons.

#### Good Morning Jacqui

We would have an objection to only being able to host 1 aquatics event at a time.

We believe that the building was designed to be able to host simulations events in the 25 metre and 50 metre pool, although this would only occur very infrequently we would still like the option.

After approx. 6 years of operating Aberdeen Sports Village we know we have the operational knowledge and exemplary safety record to be able to host large events simultaneously.

This would provide us with more options when trying to attract major sporting events to Aberdeen, something we feel very passionate about.

Please could we be able to hold 2 simultaneous events at the Aquatics centre with a maximum occupancy level of 729 on level 2.



This item was deferred from the Licensing Committee meeting on 26 April 2016 to allow the applicant to obtain a food hygiene certificate. The application requires to be determined by 06 June 2016 and the applicant has not yet provided a food safety certificate.

Members should therefore note the terms of Section 39 of the Civic Government (S) Act 1982 which states that the committee must refuse the application unless there is produced to them a certificate by the food authority (for the purposes of section 5 of the Food Safety Act 1990) stating that the vehicle, kiosk or moveable stall complies with the requirements of any relevant regulations made under that Act.
