IMPLEMENTATION OF STREET KNOWLEDGE TESTING FOR PRIVATE HIRE DRIVERS

2. With reference to article _ of the minute of meeting of the Licensing Committee of 13 December 2016, the Sub Committee had before it a report by the Interim Director of Corporate Governance which sought agreement to amend the date from which the requirement for knowledge testing for private hire drivers should be applied to applications for the grant and renewal of private hire driver licences.

The report recommended:

That the Sub Committee -

- (a) Suspend Standing Orders in order to amend the implementation date of knowledge testing for private hire drivers agreed at item 4.2 of the Licensing Committee meeting of 13 December 2016; and
- (b) Approve an amended implementation date for the application of the knowledge test for private hire car drivers to any new application lodged on or after 2 January 2017 and to any renewal applications falling due on or after 2 January 2017, and received after 1 January 2017 where the applicant has not already passed the knowledge test.

- (ii) to approve an amended implementation date for the application of the knowledge test for private hire car drivers to any new application lodged after 5pm on 23 December 2016 and to any renewal application received after 5pm on 23 December 2016 where the applicant has not already passed the knowledge test.
