### COMMITTEE GUIDELINES/POLICY

Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 S.119(3) An application for permission under this section shall be made in writing to the local authority]by the organiser of the collection not later than 1 month before the date of the collection, or within such other period as the local authority may fix.

### GROUNDS FOR REFUSAL

The Council may refuse an application on any of the following grounds: -

- (a) that the date, time, frequency or area of the collection would cause undue public nuisance;

(b) that another collection has been granted or which is exempt, is due to take place on the same or a proximate day; and

(c) that the organiser has criminal convictions,

**and otherwise shall grant the application.**
