# • Licensing Procedure (Scotland) Regulations 2007 Update The Scottish Government has launched a consultation on the Update of the Licensing (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 2007, closing on Wednesday 6th June. It seeks seek views, in particular, on sections of the public notification process, which enable communities to have a voice in local licensing decisions.
