5 <u>ELEPHANT Study-Andrea Mohan / Niamh Fitzgeral</u>	 Prof. Niamh Fitzgerald, Stirling University and Andrea Mohan, University of Dundee provided a presentation on the ELEPHANT Study. Thanks were provided to the LLF in providing support through the application for funding process. Members were advised that the study was funded by the National Institute for Health Research Public Health Research Programme and was a three-year study. During the presentation and discussion, the following information was provided:- The core focus of the study was on the changes to late night opening hours in two cities. Members were advised that the study was considering how it could be adapted to consider the impact of more recent restrictions on licensed premises put in place due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The aim of the Study was considered – the aim of the study was explained as – to understand and evaluate the contributions of changes in trading hours for bars and clubs in Glasgow and Aberdeen and the impact to harms, services and costs in the local night- time economy, and implications for other major UK cities. An overview of the studies of the 7 research questions was provided. The presentation provided an overview of where the Licensing Forum members might become involved.
