Drivers must make passengers aware in advance that extra charges may be added to the fare"; (ii) to instruct the Chief Officer - Governance to advertise the proposed scales agreed in a newspaper circulating in its area for at least one month together with the general effect of the proposed scales and the date when it is proposed that they will take effect; and		

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		(iii) instruct the Chief Officer-Governance to submit a report to the Licensing Committee on 22 March 2022 on the outcome of the consultation on the proposed scales and seeking a final decision on the future taxi fare levels to be adopted from 31 May 2022.
