With reference to article 18 of the minute of the previous meeting of 6 September 2022, the Committee had before it an information note prepared by the Chief Officer – Governance in respect of the application, which advised that following inspection, the applicant's modified vehicle did not meet the Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle (WAV) specifications of the Licensing Authority.

The Committee resolved:-

- (ii) that if the vehicle meets the required WAV measurement specifications set by the Licensing Authority, the Chief Officer Governance could grant the application under delegated powers, however if it did not, the application be referred to the Licensing Committee for consideration.
