LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 OCCASIONAL LICENCE APPLICATION THE SPIDERS WEB, 19-21 STATION ROAD, DYCE, ABERDEEN, AB21 7BA

I refer to the above application for the dates 23 November to 6 December 2020 and in terms of Section 58(1)(b)(ii) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, I make the following representation in relation to the application and request it be granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Where there is no existing delineation/boundary, the area to be delineated by barrier or similar.
- 2. Signage to be displayed indicating that alcohol is not to be removed from the licensed area:
- 3. No amplified music to be played therein (when or if music is permissible again);

Additionally I wish to bring the following to your attention.

During the evening of Thursday 12 November 2020, the Scotland versus Serbia European Championships qualifying football fixture took place and was televised.

Aberdeen City Council's Environment Health Team has advised Police Scotland of video footage allegedly taken within the applicant premises towards the conclusion of the fixture, during which time customers celebrated by shouting, cheering, jumping and hugging, thus disregarding rules in relation to the current Covid regulations.
