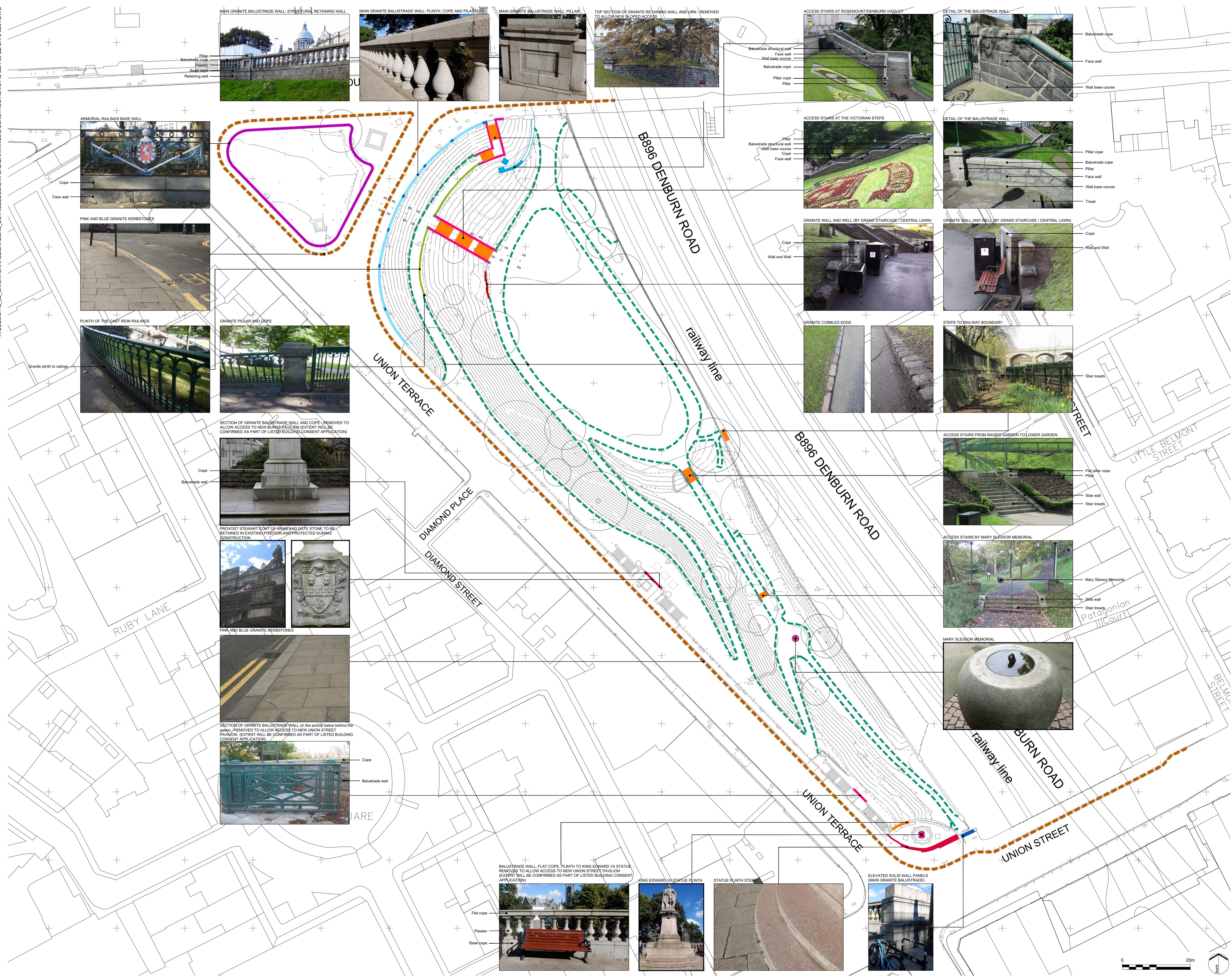


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- LEGEND**
- GRANITE DOWNTAKINGS**
- Granite Wall and Cope
 - Main Granite Balustrade Wall (Pillar, Plinth + Cope + Pilasters, Retaining Wall)
 - Granite Balustrade Wall around the Statue of King Edward VII (Plinth, Cope, Pilasters)
 - Elevated Solid Wall Panels part of the Granite Balustrade Wall to Union Street
 - Granite Plinth of the Cast Iron Railings to the path connecting the Grand Staircase with the Rosemount/Denburn Staircase
 - Granite Kerbstones in Corrie Pink Granite and Blue Dyce Granite
 - Granite Cobble Edge
 - Granite Balustrade Wall to main staircases (Rock Faced Dyce Grey Granite Wall + Dressed Kennay Base Course)
 - Granite Side Walls, Pillars and Copes (typically constructed to hold cast iron street lamps)
 - Granite Retaining Wall and Urn (Rosemount Viaduct)
 - Granite Retaining Wall and Well (adjacent to Central Lawn / Grand Staircase)
 - Grey Granite Stair Treads
 - Steps to Plinth of the Statue of King Edward VII to the junction of Union Street and Union Terrace (Polished Red Peterhead Granite)
- HISTORIC FEATURES BEING RETAINED / REPOSITIONED WITHIN PROPOSALS**
- Provost Stewart Coat of Arms and Date Stone to be retained in existing position and protected during construction- minimal restoration works required.
 - Mary Slessor Memorial in White Kennay Granite to be carefully uplifted and repositioned as existing when relocated into new position.
 - Plinth and Statue of King Edward VII to junction of Union Street and Union Terrace to be carefully uplifted to allow roof slab works to be undertaken and reinstated in existing location on completion of works to roof toilets.

Notes:

Any surplus granite to be removed and transported from Union Terrace Gardens to Aberdeen City Council's dedicated storage facility (Sclattie Quarry, Bucksburn)
