UPDATE:

On 3 February 2022, the City Growth and Resources committee approved the erection of a plaque commemorating Chanonry Grounds, home ground of the Aberdeen Association Football Club from 1888 to 1898.

The Council's scheme does not allow any notice of sponsorship to appear on the plaque, in the interests of keeping the scheme consistent and clearly identifiable.

As the nominating body AFC Heritage wished to acknowledge their sponsorship of the plaque with "AFC Heritage" added to the bottom edge of the plaque, in keeping with other plaques they have erected independently, AFC Heritage have withdrawn from the official Aberdeen City Council commemorative plaque scheme.

AFC Heritage has been made aware that withdrawing from the scheme means that the Council has no further responsibility for its promotion or upkeep.
