1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To update the Committee on changes to policies on Age of Vehicles and Vehicle Type.

2. RECOMMENDATION(S)

That the Committee :-

- 2.1 agree to remove the policy on vehicle types following the addition of vehicle dimensions; and
- 2.2 agree to consult with the trade and the public on whether the age of vehicle policy is still necessary.

3. CURRENT SITUATION

- 3.1 The current policy on vehicle types states that the following vehicle types are permissible as licensed Taxis-
 - Saloon Car (min 4 doors and 4 passenger seats) for pre 1994 licences only
 - Estate Car (derived from a saloon only- min 4 doors and 4 passenger seats) for pre 1994 licences only
 - MPV (8 passenger seats or less) for pre 1994 licences only
 - WAV (Must meet current <u>WAV specifications</u>)
- 3.2 All other vehicle types are accordingly not permitted.
- 3.3 The policy was designed to ensure that a vehicle could carry the required number of passengers and luggage. Following the addition of required

dimensions, including ground clearance, seat width and boot space, at the policy review in 2022 it is suggested that the policy is no longer required.

- 3.4 The current age of vehicles policy states:
 - WAV taxi vehicles must be 10 years old or less at first licensing and at substitution.
 - All other taxi and private hire vehicles must be 5 years old or less at grant or substitution (including substitution onto pre 1994 taxi licences.)
- 3.5 The Committee has asked officers to review the policy to ensure it is still fit for purpose. It is suggested that the best means of doing so is to hold a brief consultation exercise with the trade and the public as well as a peer-review exercise, the results of both of which can then be reported back to Committee
