I refer to the above application and in terms of Section 73(3)(a) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, I have to advise you that the applicant, based upon the details provided to Grampian Police, has not been convicted of any relevant offence.

I am also unable to confirm the existence of any foreign offence in respect of the applicant.

Numerous attempts to contact the applicant have been unsuccessful, after which the applicant failed to attend at a prearranged interview at Grampian Police Headquarters, Queen Street, Aberdeen. As a result it has not been possible to complete the enquiry into the application within the 21 day notice period nor confirm the identity or age of the applicant.

The Chief Constable therefore notes the terms of section 74(2)(a), 3(a) and (4) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, and is of the opinion that all conditions in relation to the applicant have not been met and that the application be refused.
