1: Purpose of the Report

i. To inform and seek approval from Joint Committee for 5G Pop-Up network project material change request.

2: Recommendations for Action

It is recommended that the Joint Committee:

i. Approves the material change request (Appendix A).

3: Summary of Key Information

- Project 5G ONE Pop Up Network Digital Infrastructure Business Case Gap Analysis was approved at Aberdeen City Region Deal (ACRD) Joint Committee in November 2022.
- ii. The project objective is to drive the adoption of 5G in key sectors of the regional economy including energy, utilities, ports and logistics. The potential to expand its activities by funding 'pop up ' coverage in the region to enable companies to test applications in a real-life environment.
- iii. The initial deployment revealed several challenges, including limited technical capabilities of businesses, delays in installation and suitability assessments, seasonal industry challenges, evolving equipment

specifications, high costs of Internet of Things and 5G devices, and longer deployment times needed.

iv. The recommendation of the material change request (Appendix A) is to proceed with Option 2 to change project delivery approach, adjust key deliverables and deployment timelines to maximise the impact for recipient businesses and deliver high-impact case studies and a playbook for regional digital transformation, focusing on fewer, more impactful deployments.

4: Finance and Risk

i. The total budget of £327,200 and the overall project timeline remain unchanged. The revised claim profile will support continued project delivery.
