object to the proposed extended opening hours of KFC 152 Union Street, Aberdeen, AB10 1QT, on the grounds of the following:

- 1) The noise level outside my home – the ventilation system, machinery, staff and customers – as it would disturb my sleep and thus interfere with both my work life and my personal life.
