To whom it may concern,

We would like to object to application reference, 120954, 1 x DSLAM Telecommunications Broadband Cabinet, adj to

9 St Swithin Street Gladstone

Place, Aberdeen for the following reasons:

1. Detract from value of our property.
2. There are already an unsightly box at the corner of our property and a parking meter at our side entrance so feel we're being unfairly used as a site for everybody else's convenience.
3. Concern about damage to our property during the install.
4. The side door just adjacent to the proposed install is our main access to our house and don't want to see this huge box every time we come in or go out.
5. There's already a large tree kerbside just before the proposed install which is causing the pavement to swell and buckle so the box would narrow the pavement further making it harder to manouever around with prams. Once the unit is in it leaves the absolute minimum of 1.8 m of clear pavement space to the edge of the road and it's a very busy place for parents dropping off and picking up their children from the local school.

As an alternative we would propose that the unit be installed further down Gladstone Place just before the small lane at the rear of our property. The area is double yellowed so there's no longer the issue of kids being dropped off and picked up. There are no trees in the vicinity to cause obstruction on the pavement and it's not right beside anybody's access to property.
