STREET TRADER (HOT FOOD) TEMPORARY 2 UNITS, OUTSIDE MAIN ENTRANCE, UNION SQUARE

This application is before the Committee because it is for a temporary street licence (hot food). The hours sought (08.00 to 22.00) are outwith the committee's guidelines for this type of licence (08.00 to 20.00).

There is also a letter from Roads in the Committee's papers for consideration. A plan showing the location of the proposed units has been requested from the applicant.

The applicant has not provided a food safety certificate of compliance for his unit. Members should therefore note the terms of Section 39 of the Civic Government (S) Act 1982 which states that the committee must refuse the application unless there is produced to them a certificate by the food authority (for the purposes of section 5 of the Food Safety Act 1990)] stating that the vehicle, kiosk or moveable stall complies with the requirements of any relevant regulations made under that Act.

It is a temporary application to cover a 6 week period commencing 23 November.
