## BACKGROUND/MAIN ISSUES

At its Statutory Meeting on 16 May 2012, Council considered reports on the appointment of members to specific sub-committees, groups, Council-supported trusts and boards (CG/12/056), on the appointment of representatives to outside bodies (CG/12/57) and on the appointment of members to the Pensions Panel.

With regard to the final report above, the Council resolved to appoint a Pensions Panel of four members on the basis of 1 Labour member, 1 SNP member, 1 Liberal Democrat member and 1 Conservative member. Councillor Forsyth, as Conservative Group Leader has now intimated that Councillor Thomson is relinquishing his place on the Panel and the intention is that he be replaced by Councillor Reynolds

of the Independent Alliance Group. The Council is requested to agree this change.

With regard to report CG/12/057 above, the Council resolved to agree that a meeting of Group Leaders be held in early course to agree the appointment of members to the various bodies listed in appendices appended to that report. One of the appointments agreed through this process was that of Councillor Taylor to be the Council's representative on COSLA's Community Wellbeing Executive Group. The Council is requested to note that Councillor Lesley Dunbar has now replaced Councillor Taylor in this role.

## 6. IMPACT

Representation on the various sub-committees, trusts, boards and outside bodies assists the Council in fulfilling its role in delivering the Single Outcome Agreement.
