1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

Following Aberdeen Football Club's (AFC) success in the Scottish League Cup Final on Sunday 16th March 2014, this report seeks Aberdeen City Council's support in funding, organising and delivering a celebration parade down Union Street on Sunday 23rd March 2014 at 1pm.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

- ii) Members are asked to agree funding up to £25,000 from the Common Good Fund in support of a celebration parade for Aberdeen Football Club and its supporters in Aberdeen.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4. OTHER IMPLICATIONS

5. BACKGROUND/MAIN ISSUES

Following Aberdeen Football Club's progress through the rounds of the Scottish League Cup, Aberdeen City Council approached the management team at Pittodrie Stadium to discuss proposed celebration plans, should the club be successful in winning its first piece of silverware in 19 years.

Without wishing to preempt the outcome of the Final on Sunday 16th March 2014, discreet discussions were held with all relevant operational support partners to discuss the organisation of a celebration parade on Union Street in Aberdeen for the supporters of AFC, residents of and visitors to Aberdeen supporting the city's civic pride in its local football team.

Following a productive meeting at AFC, it was agreed that the existing model currently deployed for other parades in Aberdeen across the year would be deployed but with increased security and medical and welfare provision. This would address the need to deal with the anticipated large number of people who would wish to view the parade and celebrate in Aberdeen city centre on this special occasion.

All partner agencies have agreed their role and responsibilities and a timeline for the parade has been agreed commencing at 1pm from Albyn Place and will terminate outside Aberdeen's Town House at approx 1.50pm.

The parade will provide safe photographic opportunities along the route for supporters to capture this celebrated moment.

Following the parade, AFC staff, management team, players and ACC invited guests will enjoy a Civic Reception in the Town House from 2-3pm with all AFC representatives departing soon after this time.

Civic hospitality for this occasion has already been agreed under Aberdeen City Council's delegated powers.

Subject to Aberdeen City Council's agreement, final preparations will now be made to ensure that a safe and enjoyable occasion is provided for all who wish to join and support AFC's Scottish League Cup winning celebrations on Sunday 23rd March 2014.
