TAXI DRIVER'S LICENCE (NO.1175) - SUSPENSION HEARING

3. The Sub Committee had before it correspondence from the Chief Constable, Police Scotland, c/o Aberdeen City Division and heard Sergeant Gillian Flett speak in its support.

TAXI DRIVER'S LICENCE (NO. 1084) - SUSPENSION HEARING
