2.	<p>Motion by Councillor <u>Graham</u></p> <p>“That this Council calls upon the Scottish Government to increase its 09/10 allocation of funding to Aberdeen City Council in order to prevent further cuts to services to the elderly, disabled and those less fortunate within Aberdeen. Furthermore, this Council Administration honours their promise to the people of Aberdeen during the protest march back in April 2008 by instructing the Chief Executive the write to the Scottish Government demanding that Aberdeen City Council receives a fairer funding settlement consistent with the Scottish average. That the Leadership writes to all Aberdeen city constituency and North East list MSPs calling on them to support Aberdeen City Council’s plea for a better funding settlement.</p>	12.11.08	The Committee approved the terms of the motion and a background report was submitted on 21 January.	<p>At the meeting of 3 March, 2009, the Committee agreed the recommendations in the report and requested that a letter, signed by all party leaders, be sent to partners across the city, such as NHS Grampian and the Chamber of Commerce. This was to be sent along with a copy of the previous Leadership Board letter attached to show the cross-party work which the Council was undertaking to pursue a fairer funding settlement and to seek support across the city.</p> <p>At its meeting on 8th December, 2009, the Committee considered an update report on the matter and agreed (a) that a letter from the Chief Executive in connection with the matter be sent to the Scottish Government prior to the Christmas break; (b) that the Chief Executive and the Leadership Board continue to press the case for a fairer funding settlement; (c) that officers investigate the possible benefits to the Council of a change in the floor level; and (d) to request that all political parties put their weight behind the campaign for fairer funding.</p>	Head of Service, Office of the Chief Executive	04.03.10	No
