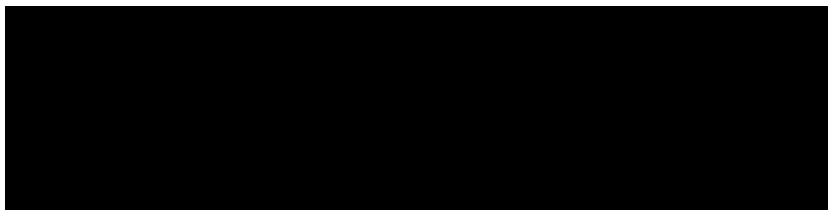
TO KILL THIS LOVE
