I refer to the above application and in terms of Section 21(4)(a)(i) and (ii) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, I have to advise you that neither the applicant nor any connected person has been convicted of any relevant offence.

The applicant has requested that sales of alcohol for consumption on the premises commence at 0500 hours daily. In terms of Section 22(b), and with regard to the proposed commencement hour, the Chief Constable wishes to draw the Board's attention to 20.4 of their Statement of Licensing Policy, November 2013-November 2016, which states, "The Board further considers that it would be extremely difficult for any applicant to justify the sale of alcohol prior to 10:00 hours... unless there are exceptional circumstances".

In respect of the above statement, the Chief Constable acknowledges that the applicant's proposed trading hours for on-sales are commensurate with other premises that are licensed in terms of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 within the airport infrastructure.
