### **Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005**

#### **Application for Provisional Premises Licence**

**Address: Little Malaya, 25 Inverurie Road, Bucksburn, Aberdeen AB21 9LJ**

In terms of Section 22 (1) (b), I make the following representation to the Licensing Board.

In regards to the licensing objective – ‘Protecting Children from harm’, I highlight the following points:

- 1) The application mentions that children and young persons can access the Premises to order and collect takeaway food.
- 2) The application lists “Young persons can access the Premises for the purposes of having a meal and ordering and collecting takeaway food”.

In response to these points, I have the following comments.

- 1) If the application is granted with these terms, unaccompanied children and young persons could access the Premises to order and collect a takeaway meal at any time. I have raised this with the agent who represents Little Malaya. The agent decided that the Takeaway waiting area (as listed on the Layout plan) would be used for unaccompanied children and young persons to order and collect the takeaway meal. If the information listed within Question 6 of the Operating plan is amended to reflect the changes, I will have no further comment in regards to point one.
- 2) If the application is granted with these terms, unaccompanied Young persons could be permitted access to all parts of the Premises and at all times in order to have a meal. I cannot support the application if young persons are allowed to have unaccompanied access for the purpose of consuming a meal after 9pm.
