Comment : I am shocked and disappointed that CALA who are so keen to integrate the new houses at Oldfold into the existing community are seeking to move an existing bus stop which serves the needs of Milltimber well away to be closer to the new development and in fact have already put in place the bus stops for which they are seeking planning permission. The new stop heading out towards Culter is on a very narrow poorly lit section of pavement and is further away from the existing pedestrian crossing. In addition the current stop is closer to the Torn-a-Dee development which caters for the needs of the older population and CALA are seeking to move this amenity away from this needy population. As a family member of someone who is considering purchasing a property within the Torn-a- Dee development and who is reliant on public transport this is of serious concern. I feel CALA is displaying little consideration for the existing residents of Milltimber. It is also disappointing that this has not been publicised at all when it is something which will impact many people.
