We received the application on the 21st December I did not return to the UK from work until the 23rd, I had tried to contact your office over the festive period but due to the time of year the office was closed, I spoke with Robert Forbes yesterday (05-01-16) who has given me your name.

I wish to register my objection to the planning application 151807, McIntosh Plant Hire held a pre planning application meeting in the middle of last year again unfortunately due to work commitments I was unable to attend but my wife attended the meeting, I have enclosed the correspondence at that time (please see attached previous emails).

I feel if the land behind my property is resurfaced etc it will encourage the water to pool round the boundary of my property. I have spoken with my neighbour who has lived next door for some years to find out that there used to be a gully or v in the field behind our property's that channelled the excess water and rain water to the stream the next field down, this has since been filled in due to the resurfacing over the years.

Hello Bert,

Further to our conversation regarding the Agricultural improvement of the ground next to my property. As you were aware on the day I had concerns regarding the stagnate water that surrounds my property at the moment. As i am to believe in your final plans the gradient of the field will leave the water running towards my property encouraging more water to collect there. I,m sure you are aware of the health risks from stagnate water, Weils Disease , Leptospirosis , fluke and the list goes on... As i have a child with and ongoing health issues you can understand why this is a huge concern for me.

As discussed with yourself and Mr Wildi on the consultation day I am hoping it is possible that you can re-conture the land next to my house and council will remove the current "red tape" and allow you to improve ground right to my property in a way that will encourage the water to run away from the property as the plans stand at the moment I only predict a "mini moat " situation as along with the rain waters the farmer also sees fit to dump his slurry from his dairy farm next to my property.

I am hoping that we can resolve these issues that i have with the current plans.
