Comment: I would like to object to this planning application for the following reasons:

- 1. The parking provided off-street is insufficient to cater for the inhabitants. This will overflow onto a street that is already overcrowded in this regard. This is seen with the Florence court development that already exists.
- 2. South Avenue is already used as a thoroughfare to Garthdee from North Deeside road, and the entrance to this property would become a potential accident blackspot, especially with the limited visibility caused by existing onstreet parking.
- 3. The existing property has many mature trees that provide an amenity to the street. Many of these have died recently, despite being covered by a Tree Protection Order. The replacement of these, especially to be allowed to grow to sufficient maturity, would become impossible with the inclusion of a large property and parking on the existing site. The existing trees add considerably to the street and surrounding area.
- 4. The proposed development would impact the privacy and visual amenity of the neighbouring properties.
- 5. The development would place undue burden on existing facilities in Cults, especially medical.
- 6. From my understanding the land title of the property prohibits the construction of more than 4 houses on the existing site.
