FUEL CELLS AND HYDROGEN JOINT UNDERSTANDING MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING - CHI/16/294

2. The Committee had before it a report by the Director of Communities, Housing and Infrastructure which sought approval for a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to be signed between Aberdeen City Council (ACC) and the Fuel Cells and Hydrogen Joint Undertaking (FCH JU).

The report recommended:-
