It is also understood that the activity of 'live performance' will involve occasional acoustic performances.

In terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the same Act, I make the following representation and request it be granted subject to the condition that the outdoor drinking facilities must be delineated by a portable physical structure/barrier when in operation and should be subject to a terminal hour of no later than 2200 hours each day.
