**LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005
APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE
ANGUS AND ALE, 55 SCHOOLHILL, ABERDEEN, AB10 1JT**

I refer to the above variation of a premises licence in terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The variation requested consists of an amendment to the operating plan to allow off sales ancillary to takeaway food, from 1100 to 2200 hours daily, including orders delivered by a delivery service.

In terms of Section 29(5) this request can be considered a variation.

In terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the same Act, I make the following representation and recommend that the variation be granted subject to the condition that the applicant must be satisfied that the delivery of alcohol will be undertaken by a person has attained 18 years of age and has received training to comply with the Licensing (Training of Staff) (Scotland) Regulations 2007.
