Application for Provisional Premises Licence

In terms of Section 22 (1) (b) (ii), I make the following representation to the Licensing Board.

In regards to the licensing objective – ‘Protecting Children from harm’ and the proposed terms for children and young person access listed within the application, I highlight the following points:

- 1) The application mentions that children are permitted unaccompanied access until 2200 hours.
- 2) The application does not refer to young persons, implying that they can have access until 0100 hours.

In response to these points, I have the following comments;

- 1) If the application is granted with these terms, unaccompanied children will have access to the premises until 2200 hours. The area in front of the bar has no fixed seating and therefore could be considered to be for “vertical drinking”. To avoid the risk of exposing children to this environment I recommend that they are accompanied by an adult after 2000 hours for the purpose of consuming a light snack or meal.
- 2) If the application is granted young persons may have access to the premises until 0100 hours. For the reasons outlined in point one, I propose that young persons are accompanied by an adult after 2200 hours for the purpose of consuming a meal.
