LEGISLATION

In terms of section 68 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, the Board may, (a) on the application of the holder of a premises licence in respect of any premises, and

(b) if the Board considers it appropriate to do so in connection with -

(i) a special event or occasion to be catered for on the premises,

or

(ii) a special event of local or national significance,

extend the licensed hours in respect of the premises by such period as is specified in the application or such other period as the Board consider appropriate.

In determining an extended hours application, the Licensing Board must take into account –

- any notice of objection given by the Chief Constable under section 69(2), and
- the LSO's report under section 69(3).

Having consider the objections/representations members must consider whether to $- \ensuremath{\mathsf{-}}$

(i) grant, or

(ii) refuse the application.
