| I am objecting to the application to vary the licencing hours at the Silver Darling on the following grounds.  1. The extended hours are likely to create public nusance around the harbour area, acess road to the marine control centre and the neighbouring residential area. Leaving the restaurant will require customers to walk thourgh the village back into town or to call taxis. This will put even more traffic pressure on the village and is considered unacceptable at 1,00 am on a Sunday morning. There is already significant pressure on the village from delivery vehicles travelling through New Pier Road (an access only road) and staff parking adjacent to the restaurant on the pedestrian thoughfare to the marine centre.  2.
