I am objecting to the application to vary the licencing hours at the Silver Darling on the following grounds.

1. The extended hours are likely to create public nuisance around the harbour area, access road to the marine control centre and the neighbouring residential area. Leaving the restaurant will require customers to walk through the village back into town or to call taxis. This will put even more traffic pressure on the village and is considered unacceptable at 1,00 am on a Sunday morning. There is already significant pressure on the village from delivery vehicles travelling through New Pier Road (an access only road) and staff parking adjacent to the restaurant on the pedestrian thoroughfare to the marine centre.

2. The restaurant sits alongside the river and clients who might be drinking for extended hours could put themselves in danger

3. The restaurant sits adjacent to a well used children's play park. This is used in the day time and in the evening by visiting and local families. The extended hours increase the potential to impact on the safety of children
