**LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005  
APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE  
BANKHEAD INN, 161-165 BANKHEAD ROAD, BUCKSBURN, ABERDEEN,

I refer to the above application for the variation of a premises licence under terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The variation requested consists of amending Question 5 to include the provision of Restaurant facilities during core hours and the wording within Question 5(f) to include weekly poker tournaments as an activity.

In terms of Section 29(5) of the Act this request can be considered a variation.

In respect of the addition of Restaurant facilities, I have no police objection.

In terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the same Act, I make the following representation.

In relation to the addition of weekly poker tournaments as an activity, I have no police objection, however in terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, I am of the opinion that the variation in its current form should be modified to state that 'poker tournaments are only permitted within the Public bar area, where Children and Young Persons do not have access or within the Restaurant area after 2000 hours, when Children and Young Persons are no longer permitted entry'.
