I refer to Section 38 (4) (a) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 in terms of the Premises Licence Review

The Licensing Standards Officers were made aware in October 2018 that the licence holder had not paid the annual fee for the above premises.

This is a breach of section 10 (2) of the mandatory conditions attached to the premises licence – Payment of Annual or Recurring Fees

The Licensing Standards Officer visited the premises – it was closed and had been closed for several months. The licence holder is Busy Busy Ltd and although attempts were made to ascertain a contact telephone number or email, these were unsuccessful.

The named premises manager, Ms Li Xiang, was contacted twice via her mobile telephone number but was either unwilling or unable to assist in notifying the licence holder regarding the outstanding annual fee payment. As Ms Xiang stated that she had no current involvement with the licence holder company, no further contact has been made with her.

The Licensing Standards Officer had no other options regarding resolving this issue and has exhausted all known avenues.
