**LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 - APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A

I refer to the above application and in terms of Section 21(4)(a)(i) and (ii) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, I have to advise you that neither the applicant nor any connected person has been convicted of any relevant offence.

I am unable to confirm the existence of any foreign offence in respect of the applicant or any connected person.

In relation to the operating plan that accompanies the application seeking core on-sales hours of 1000-0100 hours Monday to Sunday, this will exceed the guideline hours on Sunday to Thursday in terms of the Board's policy, for premises outwith the city centre.

Whilst I have no objection to the proposed terminal hour, I recommend the Board gives consideration as to whether it merits a departure from their policy.

In terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the same Act, I make the following representation.

The operating plan further indicates that they intend to provide outdoor drinking by way of a roof terrace area during and outwith core hours. I recommend that the operating plan in its current form is modified to reflect a terminal hour of 2200 hours and no amplified music, in relation to that area.
