LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005
APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE
AMUSEMENT PARK, CONGO ADVENTURE GOLF AND MIAMI BEACH,
BEACH BOULEVARD, ABERDEEN, AB24 5ED

I refer to the above application for the variation of a premises licence under terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The variation requested consists of including the external area to one of the premises licences pertaining to the complex.

In terms of Section 29(5) of the Act this request can be considered a variation.

In terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the same Act, I make the following representation.

The area to be licensed has, for some time also been utilised for music events and themed nights.

In terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, I am of the opinion that the variation in its current form should be modified to reflect the following points:

- 1. The external area to have a terminal hour of 2300 hours daily;
- Control measures to be in place to ensure no access by children and young person to events for person aged 18 years and above, such DJ/dance music events;

- 3. Adequate stewarding to be in place commensurate with the activity ongoing, including ordinary trading days;
- 4. For events other than ordinary trading involving 500 persons or more, prior notification of no less than 21 days to be to be given to Police Scotland;
- 5. Signage at egress points regarding alcohol not being taken outwith and to include reference to the local bye-law.

This representation is submitted for your attention when considering this application.
