Of particular note to this Service is the part of the application referring to allowing outdoor drinking. In order to reduce the risk of noise nuisance to neighbouring residents I recommend that the following are attached as conditions –

1. The use of the outdoor area ceases at 2200,
2. The use of amplified music is not permitted
3. implementation of a formal written Noise Management Plan (NMP), agreed in writing with this Service, for all reasonably foreseeable noise sources associated with the business activities to protect amenity of the neighbouring residents.

The NMP is intended to reasonably demonstrate noise impact has been assessed by the business and suitable controls formalised for the purposes to both demonstrating these controls and for staff training purposes. The NMP and its acceptability by this service is not, however, an exemption from the statutory nuisance provisions should a justified complaint occur.
