**LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005
APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE
ICELAND FOODS PLC, 461-475 GREAT NORTHERN ROAD, ABERDEEN,
AB24 2BD**

I refer to the above application for the variation of a premises licence under terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The variation requested consists of the following requests, namely;

1. Amend the core off-sales hours from 1000-2000 hours Monday to Sunday to 1000-2200 hours;
2. Removal of the wording within Q4 relating to seasonal variations;
3. Amend Q5 to include the provision of recorded music during and outwith core hours;
4. Amend the wording within Q5 to include the provision of home deliveries and sale of groceries outwith core-hours.

In terms of Section 29(5) of the Act this request can be considered a variation.

In respect of points 1-3, I have no adverse comment to make.

In respect of point 4 and in terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the same Act, I make the following representation.

The operating plan that accompanies the application shows that the applicant seeks to include deliveries as shown within other activities. My understanding is that this may also include the sale of alcohol. I request that should the Board be minded to grant this element of the variation, consideration be given to attaching a

condition that the licence holder will ensure that adequate training, particularly in respect of Challenge 25, is in place for persons delivering alcohol. Should such delivery be contracted to a third party, I recommend that the licence holder is satisfied that the contracted company has such measures in place.

This letter is submitted for your attention when considering this application.
