LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE MUSA (NOW HOP & ANCHOR), 33 EXCHANGE STREET, ABERDEEN, AB11 6PH

I refer to the above application for the variation of a premises licence under terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The variation requested consists of the following requests, namely;

- 1. Amending the core on-sales hours from 1100-0100 hours Monday to Sunday to 1100-0200 hours Sunday to Thursday and 1200-0300 hours Friday and Saturday;
- 2. Amending the core off-sales hours to 1000-2200 hours Monday to Sunday;
- 3. Include the provision of seasonal variations, permitting them to operate as per the Board policy;
- 4. Amend Q5 to include the provision of recorded music and live performances outwith core hours, in addition to during core hours;
- 5. Amend the wording within Q5 clarifying when activities are to take place;
- 6. Amend the terms of Children and Young Persons access, taking into account 'challenge 25 policy';
- 7. Amend the premises name and description of the premises.

In terms of Section 29(5) of the Act this request can be considered a variation.

In relation to point 1, in terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 and in support of the Preventing Crime, Preventing Public

Nuisance and Securing Public Safety licensing objectives I make the following representation.

In the event the premises are not considered premises to which the Licensing Conditions (Late Opening Premises)(Scotland) Regulations 2007, Section 3(2) applies, I request this element of the application be granted subject to the conditions specified within the Board's Statement of Licensing Policy November 2018 in respect Door Stewards, Radiolink, CCTV and Duty of Care being applied. I also request that a condition which states that a person who is the holder of a Personal Licence under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 is on duty for any time the premises operates after 0100 hours.
