Application for Variation of Premises Licence Premises: Legends (Nirvana),23 Crown Terrace, Aberdeen Applicant: AJM Funding Ltd

In terms of Section 22 (1) (b) (ii) I make the following representation to the Licensing Board.

With regard to the amendment to core hours I make no comment regarding Friday and Saturdays amendment to opening at 12.00

I make no comment regarding the addition of indoor/outdoor sports, televised sport and change of capacity due to a change of layout.

The premises is going to be used as a sports/pool centre with access for children and young persons. The current operating plan includes adult entertainment as an activity. I cannot see this activity being consistent with the licensing objective - Protecting children from harm. On this basis I object to the introduction of children and young persons access.

With regard to the amendment of Sunday opening hours to 10am, if this application is granted and children and young persons access the premises for pool/sports I cannot see the necessity for the sale of alcohol from 10am and therefore cannot support this part of the variation.

If the Licensing Board are minded to grant this application, I would recommend that there is a local condition attached which prohibits the adult entertainment activity, along with any permanent or moveable fixtures, fittings, posters, booths etc.. which are usually present within premises which offer adult entertainment - none of which have access for children and young persons.

If granted I also recommend that the access terms are clarified as the proposed operating plan simply states that children and young persons are allowed access during opening hours until 21.00. There is no indication of whether children and young persons are accompanied or supervised by an adult over the age of 18.
