**LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005
APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE
THE PLOUGHMAN, NORTH DEESIDE ROAD, PETERCULTER, ABERDEEN,
AB14 0QN**

I refer to the above application for the variation of a premises licence under terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The variation requested consists of the following requests, namely:

1. Amend the terminal hour of core on-sales hours on Friday and Saturday from 0000 hours to 0100 hours;
2. Amend Q5 to include the provision of outdoor drinking facilities;
3. Amend the layout plan to include the outdoor drinking, further increasing capacity of the premises.

In terms of Section 29(5) of the Act this request can be considered a variation.

In respect to points 1 and 3, I have no adverse comment to make.

In respect of point 2 and in terms of Section 22(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the same Act, I make the following representation.

It is my recommendation that the outdoor drinking area requested is subject to a terminal hour of 2200 hours, as per the Board's policy and that there is no external amplified music.

The applicant's agent was contacted and has indicated they would be agreeable to these terms.
