

In terms of Section 22 (1) (b) (ii) I make the following representation to the Licensing Board. The variation includes change of hours, Off sales, additional activities, external area, delivery of alcohol and changes to the children and young persons access terms.

I would like to highlight that, if granted the core hours for Friday and Saturday will enable 16 hours continuous trading

The applicant has agreed to the standard external area conditions as per the Aberdeen licensing board's policy - section 9 Supplementary In regards to the outdoor drinking area, as per below

- Outdoor area to be clearly demarcated onsite.
- Use of the area to cease at 2200 hours.
- No amplified music or entertainment to take place in the outdoor area.

The applicant has also agreed to the Delivery Driver Training conditions as the premises will be carrying out home delivery of alcohol

Within the premises, self-service machines are proposed and will be positioned, not in direct sight of the bar staff but will be monitored by staff using tablets and also visual observation, this will include managers, bar staff and door supervisors, however there will not be any staff positioned at or by the self-service machines. I have no objection but would like to highlight that the monitoring of any self-service machines would be essential.

A risk assessment was submitted with the application and this risk assessment has been amended and further information added. On this basis and as this is a new concept for licensed premises within Aberdeen, I would recommend that the Board members review the amended risk assessment and have the opportunity to hear from the applicants during the Board meeting
