LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE THE DUTCH MILL HOTEL, 7 QUEENS ROAD, ABERDEEN, AB15 4NR

I refer to the above application for the variation of a premises licence under terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The applicant currently holds a premises licence allowing the sale of alcohol in the outdoor drinking area between 1000 and 2200 hours daily.

The variation requested seeks the removal of the local condition relating to the outdoor area, which states that no amplified music or entertainment is to take place within the licensed outdoor area.

This condition is a standard condition for external drinking areas, as stated within Aberdeen City Licencing Board's Statement of Licensing Policy.

In support of the Preventing Public Nuisance licensing objective, during any consultation process, Police Scotland consistently recommends that no amplified music is played within any outdoor licensed area.
