Exemption from Policy – Street Trader’s Licence
Potential Applicant: - Laura Ripley

INFORMATION NOTE

Laura Ripley is seeking an exemption from the Committee Policy that states the Licensing Committee have designated the city centre (Zone 9) as an exclusion zone for street trading. There is a presumption against street trading in Union Street or any pedestrianised area in the city centre except where a special case can be made out by the applicant or licence holder.

The Committee has before it an email from Laura Ripley indicating the grounds under which she is seeking the exemption.

Should the Committee be minded to grant the exemption Laura Ripley is aware that she will be required to submit an application for the Grant of a Street Trader’s Licence as she is not currently the holder of such a licence.
