Respondent	Comments
Rosehill and Stockethill CC	<p>The Yellow Coloured Area - Kittybrewster Triangle.</p> <p>Ambivalent - Why change from R&SCC? Whilst some feel that the area is part of Woodside, others question justification for change. The completed Berryden Corridor Project will further isolate the triangle from Woodside. A clear reason for change should be presented.</p> <p>The Planning Officer for R&SCC is concerned that the large population to the north and west of Berryden & Kittybrewster will have reduced involvement in the Berryden Corridor and Ashgrove Connects projects planned to redevelop several roads in the current R&SCC area. Those projects are planned to make significant change to Ashgrove Road, Belmont Gardens Belmont Road, Laurelwood Avenue, Backhilton Road, Ashgrove Road West, and will impact a large number of R&SCC residents to the west of Great Northern Road.</p> <p>The three proposed boundary changes would transfer responsibility for much of the Southeast corner of R&SCC to three different Community Councils. The proposed changes are of areas that are on the periphery and not integral to the current areas of responsibility for those Community Councils. We believe that R&SCC is best placed to represent those communities that will be most affected by these major projects.</p> <p>It is considered that unless there is a pressing need, or overwhelming demand to change the boundaries, any decision should be deferred until after the plans and programme for the Berryden Corridor and Ashgrove Connects projects are matured and defined to permit R&SCC consultation.</p>
Woodside and Hilton CC	<p>We believe that we would be best to represent the area. As we have stated previously, families in the area have told us they feel a closer link to Woodside than they do to Rosehill. Children within the current Woodside boundary attend Kittybrewster Primary School with their school friends living close by. It would make sense to us for the school itself to be part of our boundary. We have a strong relationship with the school already and have supported them in various activities over the years, including donating equipment for the school garden. The children from the school who require after school care, attend Woodside Community Centre.</p>
